- The County will hold its 9th annual Senior Safety Forum in conjunction with "World Elder Abuse Awareness Week," June 10-15, 2019. This year's theme is "Lifting Up Our Voices" for Senior Safety in Age-Friendly Montgomery County.
- All seniors and their families are invited to take advantage of and enjoy the County's resources and programs specifically designed to support our senior residents.
- The purpose of the forum is to educate our community members, including older adults, family members, and professionals, about the presence of elder abuse, the warning signs, and where to find help.
- Opportunity to turn in unused/unwanted prescription drugs and over-the-counter medications to Montgomery County Police. Liquids, illicit drugs, needles, sharps, and syringes cannot be accepted.
- Representatives and exhibitors from organizations that assist seniors will be on hand to provide information. Many of these organizations play a direct role in helping seniors reduce their vulnerability to abuse and keeping seniors safe.
- This event is hosted by public agencies who protect the County's seniors: the Montgomery County Police Department, the Ombudsman Program, Adult Protective Services, Licensure and Regulatory Services, the State's Attorney's Office, the Office of the County Attorney, and Fire and Rescue Service. The Holiday Park Senior Center, Montgomery County Recreation Department and the ElderSAFE Center, Charles E. Smith Life Communities are event partners. Funding is provided in part by the Montgomery County Family Justice Center Foundation.
